- 1) Feb. 18, 2021 meeting minutes unanimously approved
- 2) Both Warrant articles for May 2021 town meeting moved to accept by Judy Eiseman, seconded by Joe Larson and unanimously passed.
- 3) Motion made by Judy Eiseman and seconded by Joe Larson to close the open CPA account of \$23,310.05 for Soccer goals and Pavilion project. Vote was unanimous to close this account. Tom Fanning will be in touch with Gail Weiss as to which account monies will be returned to.
- 4) Discussion on how to proceed with a possible appointed treasurer. Maybe another person to come on the CPC expressly to be a treasurer? Cyd Reiman will look into the amount of people allowed to be on the CPC and what is involved. Further discussion took place around the representatives from each sector of the CPC (Historical, Housing, and Recreation and Open Space) tracking finances to related projects.
