

BURNING SEASON

JANUARY 15 – MAY 1

- RULES AND REGULATIONS -

PERMITS

Season Permit \$15.00

Senior Citizen Season Permit \$10.00

To receive a permit, you must call the Pelham Fire Department at 253-3311 by Wednesday. An inspection will be conducted the first time you call and your permit will be issued. Once you have a season permit, you need only call and leave a message indicating your name, location and the days you plan to burn.

Burning will be permitted on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays only.

All fires must be at least 75' from any dwelling

Materials shall not be piled to exceed a height of three (3) feet

Shall not exceed a width of ten (10) feet and not to exceed a length of ten (10) feet

Burning will be permitted only between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

No fire shall be started after 12:00 noon

Note: In case of heavy winds or otherwise dangerous conditions, permits shall be invalid as provided by law.

Materials Permitted to Burn

Tree Branches

Brush

Cane

Driftwood

Forestry Debris

Materials Not Permitted to Burn

Leaves, Grass, Hay, Whole Trees, Stumps,

Tires, Plastics, Paints, Styrofoam,

Household Trash, Motor Oil,

Building Materials,

Land Clearing for Building Sites
