Joint meeting with the Housing Committee

Meeting convened at 7:04 pm

- Motion to hold public meetings for warrant articles on April 16, 2020 approved. Public Meeting will be scheduled for Thursday April 16, Dana will reserve the Ramsdell Room. Town Meeting is on May 9
- 2. Warrant Articles Fennessy Project: Adjustment to the warrant article previously approved by Town Meeting; we need to gain a new approval for the new amount
  - a. New acreage has now shrunk to about 30 acres
  - b. Our 47% is now \$32,240
  - c. Two parcels one on Poverty Mth; the other on Amherst Road
- 3. Warrant Articles 18-22 Amherst Road
  - a. Affordable housing at 18-22 Amherst Road: this is a commitment rather than a transfer of money.
  - b. Title of the warrant should reflect the properties at 18-22 Amherst Road
  - c. This money won't be spent until 2021 or 2022
  - d. Comment from committee member, "Let's try to fund this without borrowing"
  - e. Motion to approve wording approved 5 yes, 1 no\*
    - \* Judy Eiseman explained that as the representative of the Planning Board she wanted the Committee to understand that a 4-1 majority of the Board opposes spending CPA funds for housing on this project.
    - ii. See <u>attached letter</u> from the Planning Board to the CPC
- 4. Warrant Articles Regional School Track project
  - a. \$11,500 requested to support re-orientation of the track
  - b. All 4 towns are committing funds to meet \$200k: Amherst \$150k, Pelham, Leverett, Shutesbury 11.5 k each
  - c. Stuart Saginor says CPA funds cannot go to a stadium or artificial turf
  - d. Wording or article approved
- 5. CPC Budget Line Items total \$77k
  - a. Open Space, Community Housing, Historic, Budget Reserve
  - b. Admin expenses ; \$3,500
  - c. CPC Line item expenses approved by all
- 6. Dana made a motion to add performance bond to these RFPs
  - a. This is due to the poor results of the Town Meeting Hall painting job
  - b. Approved by all
- 7. CPC and Housing Committee appropriate money for admin account for FY2020
  - a. The funds approved last year are still available for both committees \$4K for affordable housing, \$1k for CPC
