1. Consideration of Minutes from October 24 meeting
  - Approved unanimously with revisions.
2. Telematics, Karen reporting:
  - Tracking vehicle use and emissions through Clean Energy Ext. at UMASS and private vendor GPS insight
  - Pelham has been approved to participate in the program. Karen is working to get all town vehicles in the program
  - Goal is to get info on patterns for vehicle use, monthly reports on each vehicle, and ideas for energy savings
  - Free for a year. Then we need to pay.
3. Relamp Project
  - Rick A. complains that contractor is unresponsive
  - Dan R. shared a list of work not complete and faulty work
  - Bob Haines of World Energy (the contractor) contacted Tony and requested sign off of the work
  - Stan recommends the EC, Rick and SB get together to get facts straight and make a plan
  - Karen is drafting a letter to World Energy telling them what their work is subpar
4. MVP projects
  - HVAC project design
    - RW Hall is on board to do the system design
    - Tony did a walk through with two RW Hall folks.
    - Oil fired water heater is out of scope of the project and will need to be addresses separately
    - Some existing infrastructure will likely be left in place, drained and labeled appropriately
    - RW Hall is already ,making headway on design
    - Jodie is in the loop
  - Community Center sensors
    - Tony needs to check sensors to give a readout
    - Needs to double check with electrician to get other sensors in place
  - Cadmus proposal
    - Discussed assessment of proposal
    - John will redline the proposal send to the committee for review then submit to Cadmus
5. Karen provided an update on non-energy MVP activities
  - Connecting community through Connect Pelham
6. Green Communities Report
  - Missing two pieces a data
  - Stan will get the report over the finish line
  - John and Stan will revisit report training late this year
  - Existing grant, Stan will tell DOER the contractor is problematic

  - Task force is working on a grant to get funds to procure support for technical and operational questions
