Meeting was called to order at 4:32 p.m.

#### **Committee Discussion Topics**

Committee members discussed process for obtaining appraisals, survey, and environmental review for 8 Amherst Road. Judy Eiseman had given Committee name of Ellen Anderson. Jim Lumley provided the following names and contact information: Helen Thelan, Bob Dillon, and Jeff Dietschler. Tilman agreed to send out invitations to submit appraisals to these people.

Committee discussed getting an environmental review of the site give that there exists a garage with a pit. Habitat will want a clean site. Alan Weiss, Rick Scott, and SWCA Environmental Consultants (formerly New England Environmental) were mentioned as possible consultants to provide the service if they are qualified. It was decided to wait on getting price quotes until we get appraisals and the seller of 8 Amherst Road agrees to a sale price.

Committee discussed possible surveyors of the lot so that any part of the site that will have a conservation restriction will be properly recorded. This service can occur after a sale price has been agreed to.

Tilman noted that Megan McDonough, Habitat for Humanity, would prefer that the area with a restriction be deeded to another party rather than have it be part of their site. This keeps things simpler for them. Future owner of the other part of the parcel is to be determined later.

Committee asked about progress of the First Time Homebuyer Program. No information available. Tilman will check with Valley Community Development Corporation on plans to hold meetings, advertising, and other outreach that might occur.

Committee discussed Housing Choice Small Town Capital Grant Program RFP. Applications are due July 11, 2019 and costs must have been incurred before June 30, 2020. The Committee felt that there were no activities that would meet that timetable. It was decided that we would not submit an application at that time.
