- 1) Did we receive text of all changes to the Pelham Zoning By-Laws that the Planning Board is proposing?
- 2) Is the Planning Board proposing by-laws or regulations or both?

- 3) Are there different and distinct by-laws and/or regulations for each of the three Village Districts?
- 4) Are there frontage and set-back requirements for each of the three districts, and if so where will they be in the zoning by-laws?

Any response from Abby Jenks will be discussed at next Housing Committee meeting.

Tilman Lukas suggested that at our next meeting we should begin to review information about housing programs previously collected by the committee. Goal is to start to focus on programs that are financially achievable and further our mission to make Pelham more affordable for people with lower incomes and for the elderly residents. Tilman agreed to put together a list of programs he has on file.
