April 21, 2021 Additional Information Needed Regarding the Waivers

- 1. Please provide 6 or 7 maps to help the ZBA deliberate about whether or to what extent to grant the request:
 - For Waiver 3(iv): A close-up map or diagram showing the extent of proposed encroachment
 - For Waiver 18: A reasonably close-up map showing which items you believe it is not possible to provide screening.
 - For Waivers 21–24 and 40–44:
 - A close-up map of the *upper* parking lot, showing the extent of proposed screening and any provisions for providing the required protection for fire lanes and emergency access points;
 and
 - A close-up map of the *lower* parking lot, showing the extent of proposed screening and any provisions for providing the required protection for fire lanes and emergency access points.
 - For Waiver 19: A close-up map showing where zoning provisions require sidewalks, and which portions will or will not meet this zoning requirement (While it is possible that the abovementioned close-up map focusing on screening could also contain this information, it would probably be helpful to have two separate maps, each of which highlights either the screening or sidewalk issues, respectively).
 - For Waivers 34–36: A map showing the type, height, and location of each of the planned signs.
 - For Waiver 47: A map showing the location where filling will occur, and, if possible, the depth of the fills, which otherwise should be described in Request 4 below.
- 2. For Waiver 37, please describe the extent to which you propose to conform to state and local bylaws regarding the grade of driveways, especially at the beginning of the driveways.
- 3. For Waiver 44, accompanying the requested maps of the parking lots, please describe the details of your plan for providing the required protection for fire lanes and emergency access points.
- 4. For Waiver 47, please provide details of your proposed fill plan, especially any that are not visible or may not be comprehensible form the requested map.
- 5. Waivers 6 and 12 seem to be blank. May I assume that these are off the table?

Tentative Schedule for Substantive Discussion of Requested Waivers

On April 28, we'll discuss Waivers 6-17 and 29. On the 5th of May, we'll discuss at least for the first time, the waivers dealing with parking, screening, driveways, and sidewalks: 18-26, 28, 37-45, 47, and 51.
