Drivers License/Vehicle Registration

The Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles is responsible for issuing driver's licenses and registration of motor vehicles. The closest Registry office is in Easthampton at 116 Pleasant Street. Office hours are Monday-Friday 9:00am – 5:00pm.

Fire Department

Garbage

Pelham residents can use the Town of Amherst Transfer Station & Recycling Center. Use of this facility requires an annual vehicle sticker and fee. The transfer station is open year-round on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturdays from 8:00am to 2:00pm and is closed on all major holidays. Hospital

Library

The Town of Pelham is covered by three newspapers, the Amherst Bulletin, the Daily Hampshire Gazette, and the Springfield Republican. The Town of Pelham sends a free quarterly newsletter called The Pelham Slate.

Public Meetings

Local Boards & Committees in Town mostly meet on set schedules every month but some meetings are varied. Public Meetings are posted in the Town Clerk's office, outside the Rhodes Building/Town Offices on the bulletin board, and on the Town's website, which can be viewed on the calendar displayed on the homepage.

Recycling

The Town of Pelham offers residents recycling once per month on the 1st Saturday, unless a holiday weekend, at the Pelham Elementary School from 9:00am to 12:00pm. There is no fee or sticker requirement for using this service. Residents can use the Amherst Transfer & Recycling Center as long as an annual vehicle sticker is purchased.

Taxes
